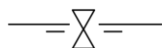




A Celebration of 20 years of Movie Magic for Families and School Visitors

- 1) At the beginning of the film, who does Harry Potter live with at Number 4 Privet Drive?
- 2) In which room does Harry sleep at Number 4 Privet Drive?

GREAT HALL

- 3) Still the original flooring from the first film, what is the Great Hall floor made from?
- 4) How was the effect of the night sky created in the Great Hall at the sorting ceremony?

GRYFFINDOR BOYS' DORMITORY

- 5) What problem did the beds give filmmakers as the actors grew up?

GRYFFINDOR COMMON ROOM

- 6) During the first film, who stands up to Harry, Ron and Hermione in the common room and says the following: "No! I won't let you. You'll get Gryffindor in trouble again. I'll...I'll fight you!"

MIRROR OF ERISED

- 7) What does the Mirror of Erised show you when you look into it?
- 8) Who does Harry Potter see when he looks into the mirror?
- 9) What does Ron see when he looks into the mirror?

The night sky was added during post-production. 5 – The actors grew too tall for the beds. 6 – Neville Longbottom. 7 – The thing you desire most in the world. 8 – His mother and father – James and Lily Potter. 9 – Ron is head boy, holding the Quidditch cup and is Quidditch captain. 10 – They used leaves, bones and stuffed animals. They would use the head from one animal and sew it to the body of another animal. 11 – Professor Snape. 12 – The Sorting Hat. 13 – Phoenix. 14 – A Norwegian Ridgeback dragon. 15 – To make the children look small. 16 – Draco Malfoy and Fang. 17 – Centaur. 18 – Mrs Weasley, Ginny and Ron. 19 – They were filmed on a set at Leavesden as the real carriages were too narrow to film in. 20 – He buys all of the sweets for him and Ron. 21 – Goblins. 22 – Special effects prosthetic make up was used to create the goblin look. 23 – 687. 24 – Ollivanders. 25 – They are made out of individual animals. 26 – The Nimbus 2000. 27 – By Boat. 28 – The castle model was placed into a green screen room. Cameras would then pan around the model to create the exterior scenes.
