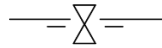

They were given a prosthetic mask to look like her 7) It is made from clear cast resin 8) A Christmas tree 9) In the Gryffindor common they are red, whereas in the Slytherin common room they are green to represent their house colours 10) Snowmen 11) Special effects are used to create the moving cake 12) 5 different types of snow were created. There were snow blankets, dendritic salt which sounds crunchy underfoot, shredded paper which was used on the Hogwarts castle which is very fine. We used shredded plastic which is used as falling snow as it catches in the air and doesn't fall straightaway and finally, we used polymer which looks the most realistic 13) It was a bright green, like a green screen.
